
CITIZEN'S GUIDE

New Bus Shelters

A new service in our municipality!

Last October, the Public Works Department installed five new bus shelters.

You can find them here:

- 1. Corner of Forest Ave. and Pincourt Blvd.
- 2. Corner of Cardinal-Léger Blvd. and Trotter Park
- 3. Corner of Pincourt Blvd. and 5th Avenue
- 4. Corner of Northcote St. and Shamrock St.
- 5. Corner of de l'Île Blvd. and du Suroît St.

The structures and lighting fixtures use LED technology. The lights will stay on all night and switch off at dawn. Public transit users will be able to wait for their next bus in these new spaces.

Vaudreuil-Soulanges Meals-on-Wheels program

A service that makes it easier for people to stay in their own homes

Are you familiar with the **Vaudreuil-Soulanges Meals-on-Wheels (Popote roulante)** program? It's a service that delivers hot or frozen balanced meals to seniors and anyone in the Vaudreuil-Soulanges region who is coping with illness, a loss of autonomy or physical limitations. Meals are prepared by volunteers at the Centre communautaire des aînés de Soulanges. Clients who are 70 or over can get a tax receipt for home-support services that covers half of their meal costs.

Meal cost: \$6, payable by cheque (with the order form) or cash (exact amount)

Included: Soup, main course and dessert

Delivery: Mondays and Wednesdays, between 11 am and 1 pm
