NEW TAILLON PARK

Training Circuit for Adults and Seniors

Starting this summer, the Town of Pincourt will offer a new training circuit for adults and seniors.

Several exercise stations will be set up, along with explanatory signs in French and English. The fitness circuit will allow you to tone various muscle groups on equipment like benches, parallel bars, monkey bars, stairs (with assistance), ab stations and a balance board (with assistance).

In addition, a new gravel path roughly 400 metres in length has been created where you can start or finish your workout.

Taillon Park will be the perfect spot to take an outdoor fitness break and enhance your physical and mental well-being.
