Regulation - MOWERS AND TRIMMERS

It is **authorized** to operate a lawn mower or lawn tractor, trimmer, chainsaw, leaf blower, or any other power tool:

- Monday to Thursday, from 7 a.m. to 10 p.m.;
- Friday, from 7 a.m. to 8 p.m.;
- Saturday, Sunday and statutory holidays, from 9 a.m. to 4 p.m.

Regulation - CONSTRUCTION WORK

It is **authorized** to carry out or cause to be carried out construction, repair, or demolition work on a property:

- Monday to Thursday, from 7 a.m. to 10 p.m.;
- Friday, from 7 a.m. to 8 p.m.;
- Saturday, Sunday, from 9 a.m. to 8 p.m.

Regulation - RECREATIONAL VEHICLE STORAGE

From March 15 to November 1 of the same year, the following recreational vehicles are authorized in the front yard:

- Camper
- Trailer tent
- Boat
- All-terrain vehicle
- Motor home
- Trailer

Regulation - CAR SHELTER

You have until April 15 to remove your winter car shelter from your property.

As of April 1, you will again be able to park your car on the street, during the night.

GARBAGE
You must place your garbage in the black bin provided by the Town. It is recommended that you place your garbage bin at the curb the day before collection, as of 6:00 p.m., to avoid missing the truck on your street.



RECYCLING
Recycling is collected every Monday.
Materials accepted in the recycling bin:

FOOD WASTE
Food waste is collected *every Wednesday*.

BULK WASTE
Bulk waste collection is held on the 4th Friday of the month.
Materials accepted: bathtubs, showers, sinks, furniture and mattresses, carpets, toilets.



GREEN WASTE
Accepted waste: garden waste, flower bed waste, grass and leaves, grass clippings, small branches less than 1 cm in diameter.
Leaf collection will take place from *May to November, every 2 weeks, on Wednesdays*.



BRANCHES
Branch collection takes place every 4th week of the month.
Branches must be placed at the curb by Monday morning. Due to high demand, the collection of branches may take place over several days.
The large end of the branches must be facing the street.

ENROLLMENT PROCEDURE

- Children under 6 must have completed kindergarten.

Daily payment is not available for the daycare service, and it is non-refundable. The childcare service is reserved for children enrolled in day camp only.

DISCOUNT

Summer package: With the purchase of 6 weeks of camp for the same child, the 7th week is free. (Not including the little camp and the daycare service.)

Family package (3 children or more): 40% discount for the 3rd child and subsequent children. (Not including the little camp and the daycare service.)

REFUND POLICY

- Fees are reimbursed 100% if the activity is cancelled by the Town.
- If the request is made before June 23, the Town will reimburse 100% of the costs, minus a \$10 administration fee.
- As from June 26, a refund will be made only on a pro rata basis for the service rendered, minus a \$10 administration fee, if the request is accompanied by a relevant supporting document (ex. medical certificate). The pro rata is calculated from the date of receipt of the application.
- Refund requests received after the end of an activity will not be accepted.

NOTE: The Town of Pincourt reserves the right to require proof of residence at any time and to expel a child with behaviour problems, without refund. Limited places.

SUPPORT PROGRAM FOR CHILDREN living with an intellectual and/or physical disability

This program is for Pincourt children, aged 6 to 14 years old, who have an intellectual and/or physical disability or who require accompaniment in order to participate in the activities. This program provides access to accompaniment during the day camp and daycare services, in order to facilitate the participation and integration of the children. Children may be matched depending on their situation.

- Enroll and pay the fees according to the regular day camp procedures.
