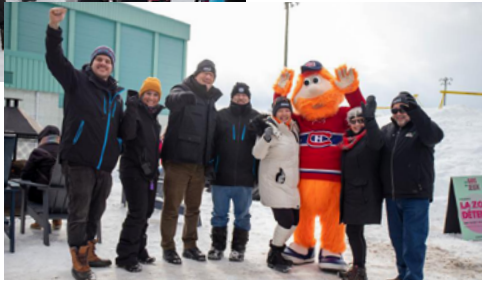

If necessary, the Council may also call special meetings during the year.

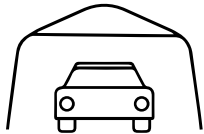

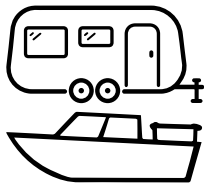


Temporary winter shelters:

- Only **one seasonal carport is permitted** per lot, from October 15, 2023 to April 15, 2024.

Caution:

Remember to clean your temporary shelters thoroughly to avoid collapse.



Summer recreational equipment (boats, trailers, etc.):

- The **deadline** for parking and storing equipment is **November 15**.

For a renewal, please only indicate any changes. It is unnecessary to fill in a new form.

WINTER PARKING

As of **November 15, 2023, and until April 1, 2024** inclusively, motorists will be able to park their cars **on the street, during the day**, as follows, unless otherwise posted:

- On the street side with **even-numbered addresses**, on even-numbered days (e.g.: November 16, I park my car on the side with even-numbered street addresses).
- Odd-numbered street addresses, on **odd-numbered days** (e.g.: November 17, I park my car on the odd-numbered side of the street).

Reminder: It is **forbidden** to park on the street overnight, between midnight and 7 a.m.

WINTER PARKING LOTS



In anticipation of winter, you can purchase a vignette for one of the parking spaces available.

Cost of permit: \$50 per vehicle

Payment : cash, cheque or Interac

The amount disbursed will cover the costs of snow removal and parking space maintenance.

Permit validity: for the 2023-2024 winter season

GREEN WASTE Green waste is collected every second Wednesday, from May to November. Spring and fall leaf collection takes place five times a year, twice in the spring and three times in the fall. The dates will be announced on our website.

BRANCHES Branch collection takes place every 4th week of the month, from May to October. Branches must be placed at the curb by Monday morning. Due to high demand, the collection of branches may take place over several days. The large end of the branches must be facing the street.
